

# *The American Cancer Society's 29<sup>th</sup> Annual Climb to Conquer Cancer*

## *FAQs*

***When and where is Climb to Conquer Cancer?*** This year's event is August 19<sup>th</sup> at Arizona Snowbowl. We ask that everyone start hiking between 7-8am.

***How do I register for the event?*** Participants must be pre-registered; there will be no day-of registration. Only 4000 registrations are available and we do sell out. Please register online at [www.FlagstaffClimb.com](http://www.FlagstaffClimb.com). Adult registration is \$40.00 per person, children 3-11 years old are \$15.00, and children 2 and under are free with a signed waiver form (no t-shirt).

***Where do we park?*** **Parking is very limited at Arizona Snowbowl.** You **must purchase a parking pass** from the ACS office for \$10 or online at the website at [www.flagstaffclimb.com](http://www.flagstaffclimb.com) In order to park at the mountain, you **MUST** have the appropriate parking pass. We encourage participants to carpool and ride the **FREE** busses from Flagstaff High School to Arizona Snowbowl. Buses will begin shuttling at 6:00am, final busses will depart at 7:30am on the Kendrick street side of Flagstaff High School.

***What are the hiking rules?*** No dogs or bikes are allowed at the event. No walking back down the mountain, per our permit with the Forest Service. Once you make it to the top of the mountain you will then take a bus down the mountain.

***Do I need to bring food and water for myself?*** Please start your hike off with a full bottle of water. We will have water stops throughout the hike with more water. Lunch will be provided at the finish line .

***Do I have to fundraise?*** We encourage everyone to raise \$100 or more, but it is not mandated. You can fundraise with emails, Facebook, community events, and our commemorative flags. You can purchase a commemorative flag to honor a loved one who has survived cancer or in memory of a loved one who has lost their battle with cancer. You can decorate the flag yourself or we can print your loved one's name on the flag. Flags can be purchased at The American Cancer Society office for \$20.00. Decorated flags must be returned to our office by August 16<sup>th</sup> for placements along memory lane.

***Where does the money go?*** Your donation to the American Cancer Society will help create a world with less cancer and more birthdays by helping people stay well, helping people get well, by finding cures, and fighting back. We offer many free programs and services to cancer patients and their loved ones. Stop by the Survivor Tent for more information.

***How long is the walk?*** The walk is 6.8 miles. If you get tired at any point please step to the far right side of the road and waive down a bus. The bus will take you to the finish line. **No unsupervised children are allowed to ride the bus.**

***I am a survivor, is there anything special for me?*** Yes! We love to celebrate survivors. Please stop by the Survivor Tent at the top of the mountain and enter to win our Survivor Drawing. We also have a Survivor Activity.
