DEADLINE to complete is June 1.

2018 update - due to rising costs each year, the rooms at Kutztown University will be \$20 per rider, guarantee single room will still be \$40.

There is the option on the Lodging Form to select a **standard room** or a **guaranteed single room**. The **standard room** are rooms that may have a roommate in your room. **Guaranteed single** room is an individual room (no roommate) within the suite.

FUNdraising App

What will the American Cancer Society FUNdraising App do?

The American Cancer Society FUNdraising App is a mobile payments app for mobile phones that allows registered fundraisers/participants to accept credit card, debit card, PayPal and check donations via their mobile device. The app also supports sending both mail and email receipts. And displays the donations made toward your fundraising efforts in near real-time.

Users of the app are also able to solicit donations from friends & family directly from the app via SMS, email, Facebook, or Twitter. Recipients will receive a mobile optimized link enabling them to make a donation quickly and easily.

Additionally, the new ACS FUNdraising app allows event participants to easily check their fundraising progress, access fundraising tools, communicate with donors and keep track of all event news.
