



Login Screen

Logging in using Society Account

Why am I being asked to create a new password?


We have updated our password criteria to make your account more secure.

Our new password criteria is: Min 7 chars with at least 2 of the following - one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter, number, or special

If a user logs in with a password that isn't complex, the app "sees" that the email address is associated with a known email address (which is shown) and allows the user to create a more complex password.

Logging in with Facebook

When user selects the Facebook button they are brought to the Facebook login screen. They just need to type in their Facebook login and then Society Account will log them in.



Logging in with Google

When user selects the Google button they are brought to the Google login screen. They just need to type in their Google login and then Society Account will log them in.

* Note: User must migrate each social account. As they migrate, their social account is incorporated into their one Society Account associated with the same email address. Multiple accounts are not created.






First time using social logins (Facebook or Google) to log in...

Once a user logs in with Google or Facebook the system will recognize that they have an existing profile for their event. They can now click on “Log in to Link Accounts” to merge their social account with their Society Account.




Accounts Linked


User will be asked to enter their event login. Once they do, they click on “Link Accounts.” Once their accounts are linked they will receive notification.

Logging in when not registered for an event





User must be registered for an event to use the app. If they aren't registered and log in they will receive a "Not Registered" message. If they click on "Register" they can find an event to register with.

Page after login – Registered for one event



Once a user completes login (and linking their social account(s) they will be taken to the home page. This is what the screen looks like when registered for one event.

Page after login – Registered for multiple events



Once a user completes login (and linking their social account(s) they will be taken to a page with a list of their events. They select the event they want to use and then are taken to the home page.


